### A Consultation on Proposals to Reform the Human Rights Act 1998

The Human Rights Act gives you legal protection of your human rights, such as your right to life, or your right to a fair trial.

The review clearly seeks to impose a rights culture that displaces personal responsibility in favour of "the public interest".

Under the proposed reforms it is clear that Parliament is seeking to impose itself as arbiter of when a person can have human rights and when they cannot.

### This is disgraceful.

It does not matter the crime, major or minor, a person's inalienable and fundamental human rights should always remain intact, including autonomy over their own body.
