## An evening with **JAMES DELINGPOLE**...

Having described himself as a 'libertarian conservative' and climate change sceptic – James Delingpole is an English columnist who has formerly written for **The Daily Telegraph**, **The Spectator**, **The Daily Mail** and **The Times**. He was an executive editor for **Breitbart** and has published several novels and four political books. He shared halls with many aspiring politicians at Malvern College and the University of Oxford.

James's journey to questioning the mainstream agenda began as he realised something wasn't quite right with the climate change narrative, believing that we should not be spending taxpayers' money on a problem that may well not exist.

He went on to write the enlightening and eye-opening book Watermelons: How Environmentalists are Killing the Planet, Destroying the Economy and Stealing your Children's Future. An important book that examines the reality

behind the infamous 'Climategate' scandal, revealing the truth behind the individuals and organisations involved, their intentions and how they have been trying to cover up and fabricate the data. He dives deeper into 'green ideology' and pokes fun at the green movements embarrassing record of apocalyptic predictions, from the 'population bomb' to 'global cooling'—both of which have failed to materialise.

James has openly questioned the mainstream narrative over the last couple of years and has subsequently gained popularity and momentum with his ever-growing podcast **The Delingpod**, where he interviews fellow sceptics in his down-to-earth and witty style.
