"Thoughts on Nato and the war in Ukraine"

As this terrible war grinds on, ...it really has become a NATO versus Russia war, with Ukrainians used as proxy fighters helping to promote US global hegemony (the real goal and purpose of NATO). When did we express our democratic will to go to war with Russia? NATO was created in 1949 to secure US power, and its relentless expansion since 1990s has seen it expand its power right across Europe.

...Eisenhower's defending "a way of life" (1954) looks distinctly American, including ideologically driven privatisation and structural readjustments to make the target country US business friendly. From World War II to the present the US economy has been built on its massive, largely privatised, military industrial complex. The Ukrainian war has been a godsend to defence industries across the Western world, especially the US.

...The evil talismans of "appeasement" and "Hitler" can be bandied about to hammer all opposition to the war. Calls for a ceasefire and negotiations are shouted down with accusations of being Putin's "useful idiots" and anti-democratic even.

This war cannot end with victory or defeat for either side, NATO or Russia...
